GOALS:

1. Our main goal is to promote the hobby of growing giant pumpkins in Manitoba and the surrounding area for both personal satisfaction and competition.
2. To help establish a level playing field for all growers of giant pumpkins by:
 - a) Facilitating the sharing of information and experience about giant pumpkins to all interested growers, through seminars, patch tours, newsletters.
 - b) Creating a local collection of giant pumpkin seeds and making those seeds available to all growers.
3. To support the development of other areas of giant growing, including but not limited to: tomatoes, watermelons, cantaloupes, etc.

MEMBERSHIP:

The money, in this first year, is going towards start up costs, a spring newsletter, and the creation of a seed bank.

Our goal is to provide all members with seeds from locally grown giant pumpkins and possibly have a draw for a few “big ones” from pumpkins grown in other parts of North America.

We are also working on supplying our members with seeds for growing giant watermelons and cantaloupes.
